

Trout Statistics

This page identifies the number of trout caught by species each year beginning in 2001, identifies the weight of the largest trout of each species and the location where the largest trout of the species was caught. Many fish were caught prior to 2001 and those species that are part of the **North American Trout Adventure** but not part of the statistics. The chart does show some interesting information. The west has been affected by a substantial drought that began in 2004. The fall-off in catch in 2005 and 2006 reflects the low water fishing in Montana and Idaho. That area has recovered, but I did not fish it in 2007. I spent a portion of 2011 and 2012 fishing in Asia and all of 2013.
